## **Learning Objectives:**

- -Identify food group foods within combination foods.
- -Relate foods to food groups shown in the pyramid.
- -Count the numbers of "individual foods" within a combination food.
- -Recognize that "Combination" means more than one.

## **Lesson Plan Text:**

Assemble "Old Lady'. Materials: Gallon-size re-sealable bag. Blackline master of Old Lady. Cut-out parts and staple to the gallon size ziploc bag. Make the parts to a cheeseburger: a bun, burger patty, lettuce, tomato, ketchup, pickle, and a slice of cheese.

Tell students that today they're going to look v-e-r-y closely at some of the foods they often eat to find out what's really in them.

Using the There was an Old Lady lyrics, sing or read the poem. Add each new food to the re-sealable bag body as you go.


